From the Pastor's Desk:

THANK YOU

On my run this morning I saw a few tree leaves starting to turn. I wanted to scream "No! Not yet!" I love the warm summer months, and although I like fall, my enthusiasm for it is always dampened by the season that follows after it. I become so focused on the dreaded long, VERY long, hard winter to come that I often find it hard to stop and enjoy the beauty of fall.

So this time of year I find myself always wanting to stop time, to stay in the warm pleasant months of summer, enjoying flowers and gardens, birds and walks in parks. However, time doesn't stop. It keeps moving forward.
